Foreign Language (six hours at the 200-level or above)

The 201/202 (3 hours/3 hours) sequence completed in one language **or** 211 (6 hours).

Fine Arts (one 3-hour course required)

Music 101, 102, 103, 105

Dance 200

Theatre 201

Art History (any 3-hour course)

Social Science (two 3-hour courses required)

Both courses may be in the same area, or two different areas may be chosen. Choose courses from the following areas:

Anthropology, Journalism 101, Psychology, Economics, Latin American Studies, Sociology, Political Science

History (two 3-hour courses required)

Humanities (one 3-hour course required)

Any Afro-American Studies course; Southern Studies 101, 102; Any Classical Civilization course; University Honors 101, 102; Any Philosophy course; Gender Studies 103, 201, 333, 311, 390; Any Religion course

Science (three 3-hour courses required)

Two of the courses must have labs, and two of the courses must be in the same area. Choose three courses from two of the following areas. If you choose to take two courses from Area A, then you must take two courses in Astronomy or two courses in Physics or two courses in Physical Science.

(A) Astronomy or Physics or Physical Science

(B) Biology

(C) Chemistry

(D) Geology

GRADE POINTS AND GRADE POINT AVERAGES
