- 7) Fine Arts-History , appreciation, and theory of art, dance, music, and theatre arts. Not performance! (e.g. AH 101 or 102, MUS 103, THEA 201, DANC 200)
- 8) Lab series must be taken as either major or non-major, not a combination of the two.
- 9) Chem 100 or 101 does not count as a Science
